BID GUARANTEE AND CONTRACT SECURITY:

Each bid proposal shall be accompanied by a certified check, bank draft or satisfactory bid bond in an amount not less than 5% of the bid amount. Checks shall be made payable to the City of Clawson. Bids may not be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) calendar days after receipt of bids. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a performance bond, maintenance and guarantee bond, labor and material bond, and insurance certificates.

FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS

The Contractor and Subcontractors on this project must comply with HUD contract provisions 24CFR part 85.36(i), the Davis-Bacon Act, Nondiscrimination, Equal Employment Opportunity, Affirmative Action, Section 3 requirements, Anti-Kickback Act, Federal Occupational Safety and Health Act and Department of Labor Standards and Regulations as set forth in the Contract Bid Documents.
