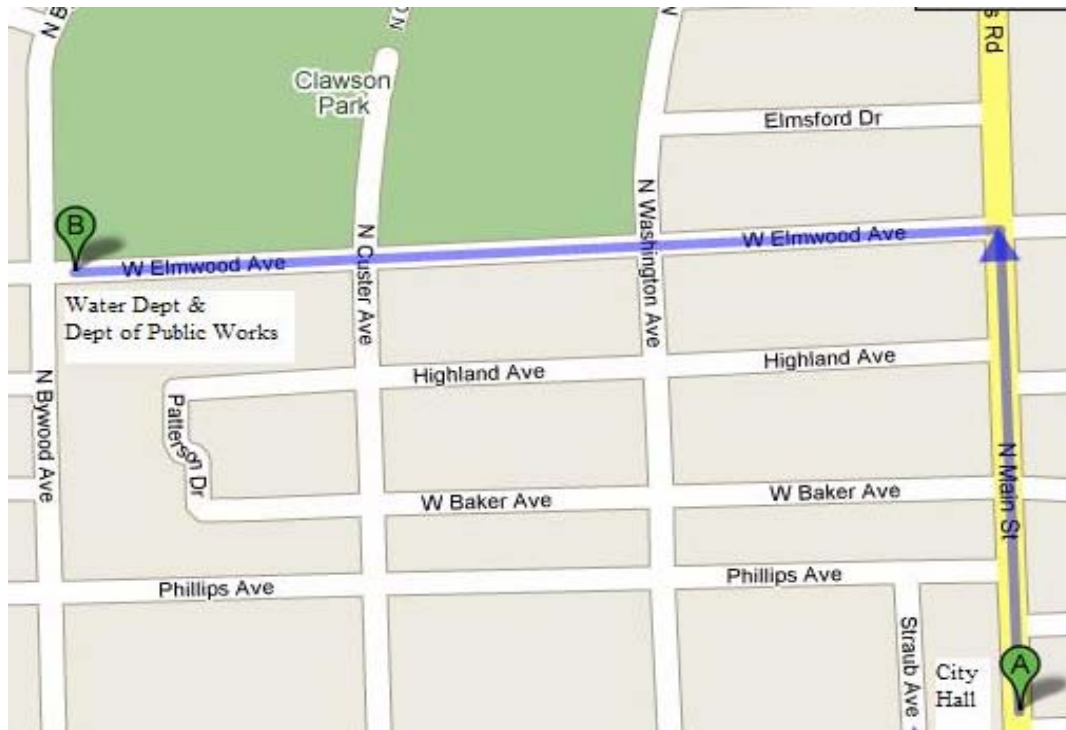
1) Where is the Water Department located?

5) Where do I get a recycle bin & what is the cost?

Recycle bins can be picked up at the DPW Mon thru Fri 7am to 3:30pm.

There is no charge but proof of Clawson residency is required (example, drivers license)

6) What day is trash pick up?

Trash pick is on Wednesday for the entire city.

7) What day is trash pick up when there is a holiday?

If the holiday falls on a Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday, your trash will be picked up on Thursday.

7) Can we have a backyard campfire?

The City of Clawson does allow recreational fires.

A fire permit must be obtained from the City Clerk's office first.

It lasts for 5 years and there is no cost.
