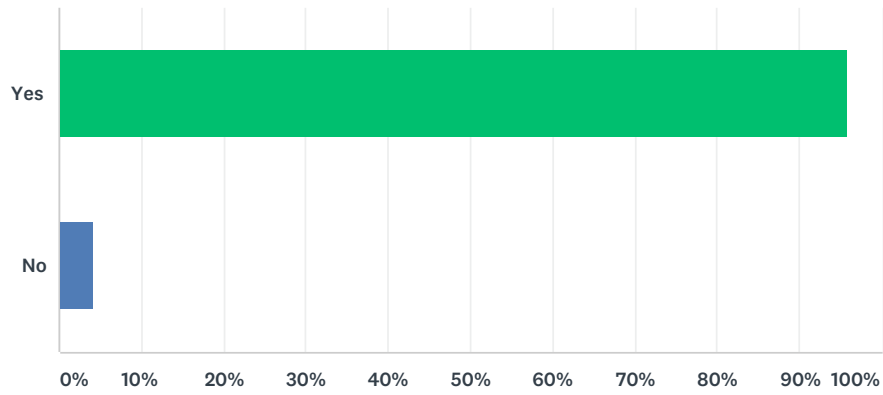


Q1 Have you or members of your household visited any of City of Clawson's parks during the past year?

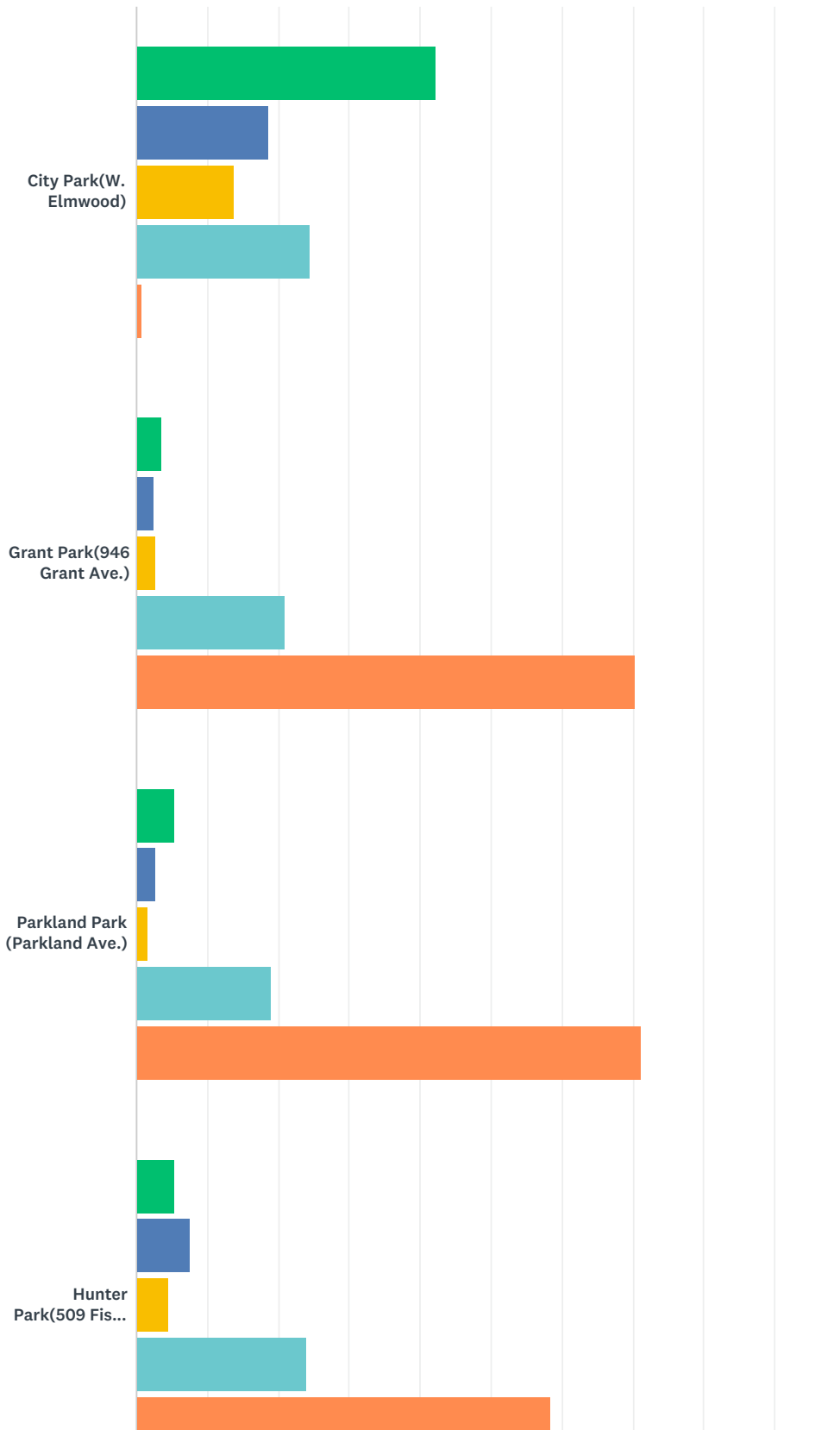

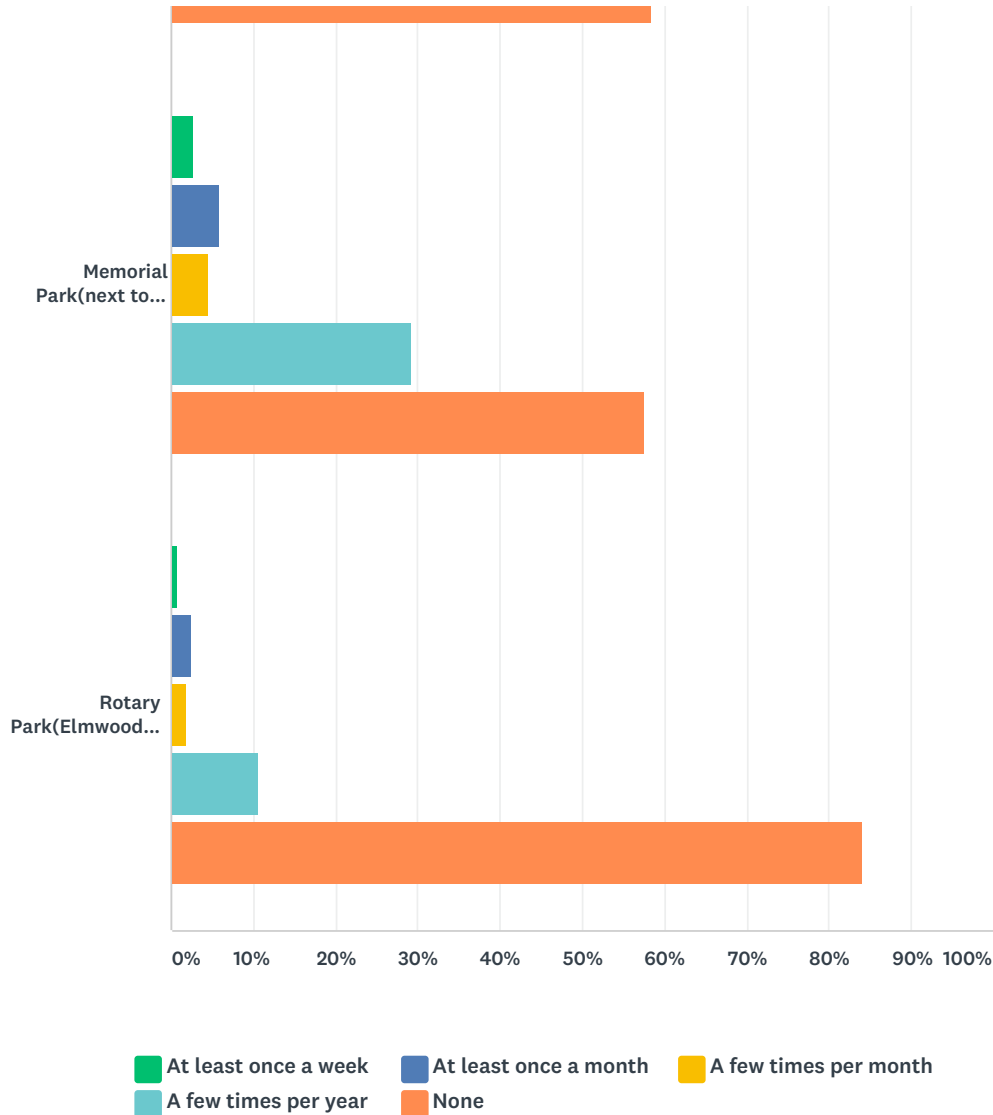

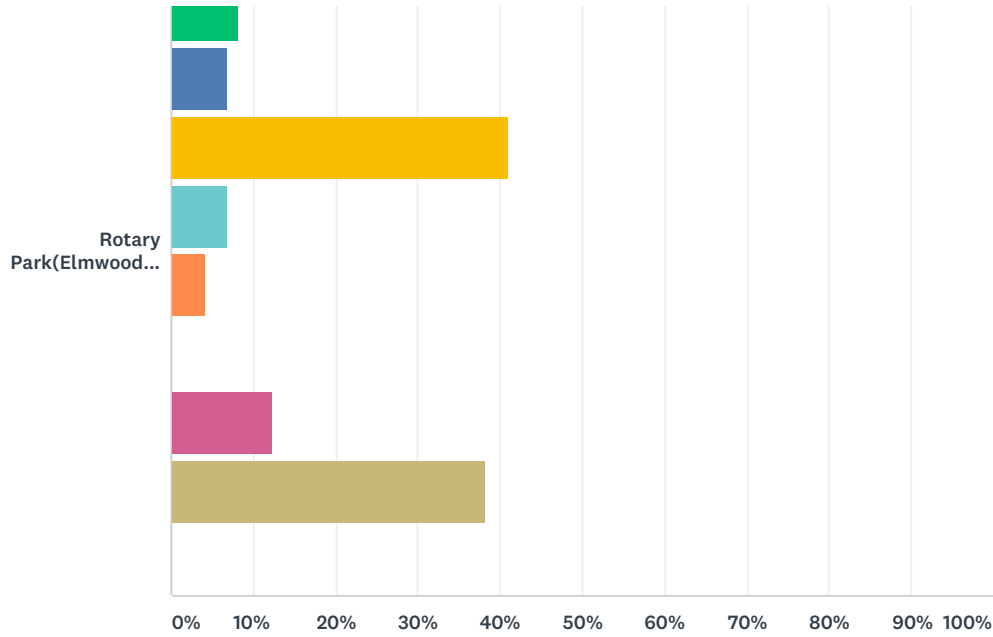

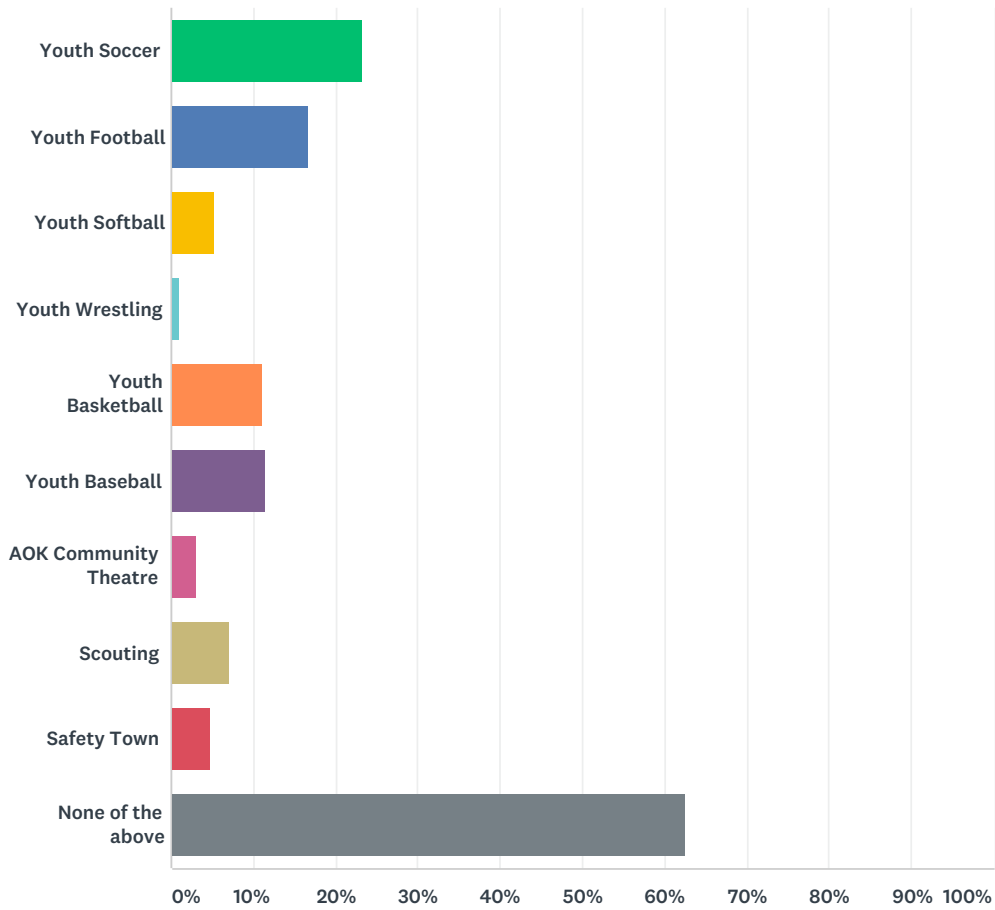

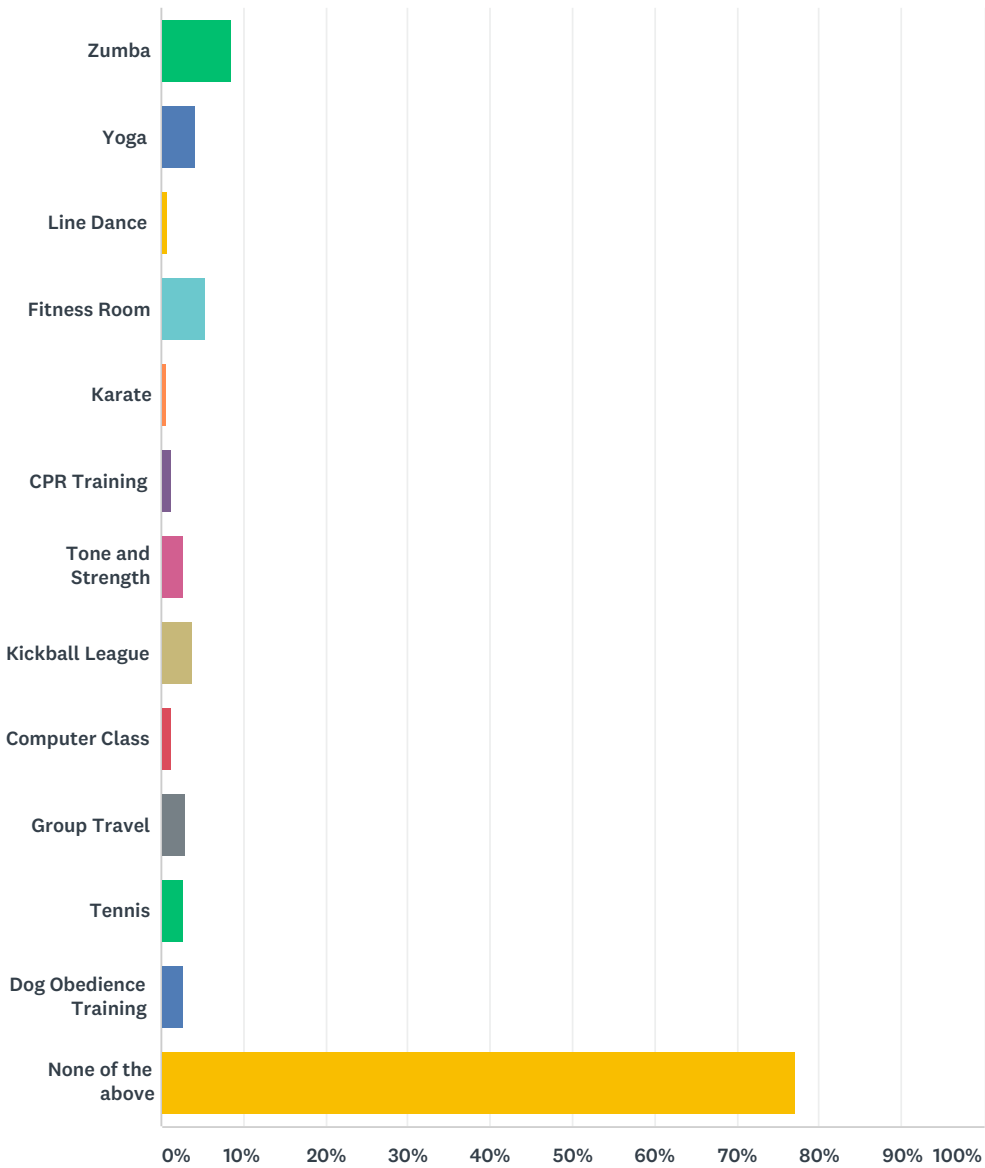
