

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: **Where can I find parking and how much will it cost? Is there valet parking?**

A: Ample parking is available along the football field, surface lot just North of the market area and on surface streets adjacent to the Clawson City Park, it is free. No valet parking is offered.

Q: **Is the Clawson Farmers Market wheelchair accessible? Are there wheelchairs available?**

A: The CFM is held on a paved surface (parking lot) and is wheelchair accessible; no wheelchairs are available for use from the CFM.

Q: **Are there public restrooms at the Clawson Farmers Market?**

A: Yes, public restrooms are located in the adjacent Clawson City Park next to the pavilion.

Q: **Do the vendors accept credit cards?**

A: Vendors do not accept credit cards, cash only.

Q: **Does the Clawson Farmers Market have a lost & found?**

A: Yes, the CFM does have a lost & found.

Q: **Is the Clawson Farmers Market open when it rains?**

A: The Farmers Market is open weekly, rain or shine.

Q: **Is my pet allowed at the Clawson Farmers Market?**

A: Yes, your pet must be properly licensed, on a leash and under your control at all times; as well you are responsible to make sure any accidents are cleaned up.

Q: **Is alcohol served or available for purchase at the Clawson Farmers Market?**

A: No, alcohol is not served or available for purchase at the CFM.

Q: **We are a group looking to attend the Clawson Farmers Market, how do I schedule parking for a bus or shuttle?**

A: Please contact us and we will do everything possible to accommodate your needs.

Q: **Is entertainment offered at the Clawson Farmers Market?**

A: Yes, if you are interested in performing please contact us.

Q: How much should I plan to spend at the Clawson Farmers Market?
